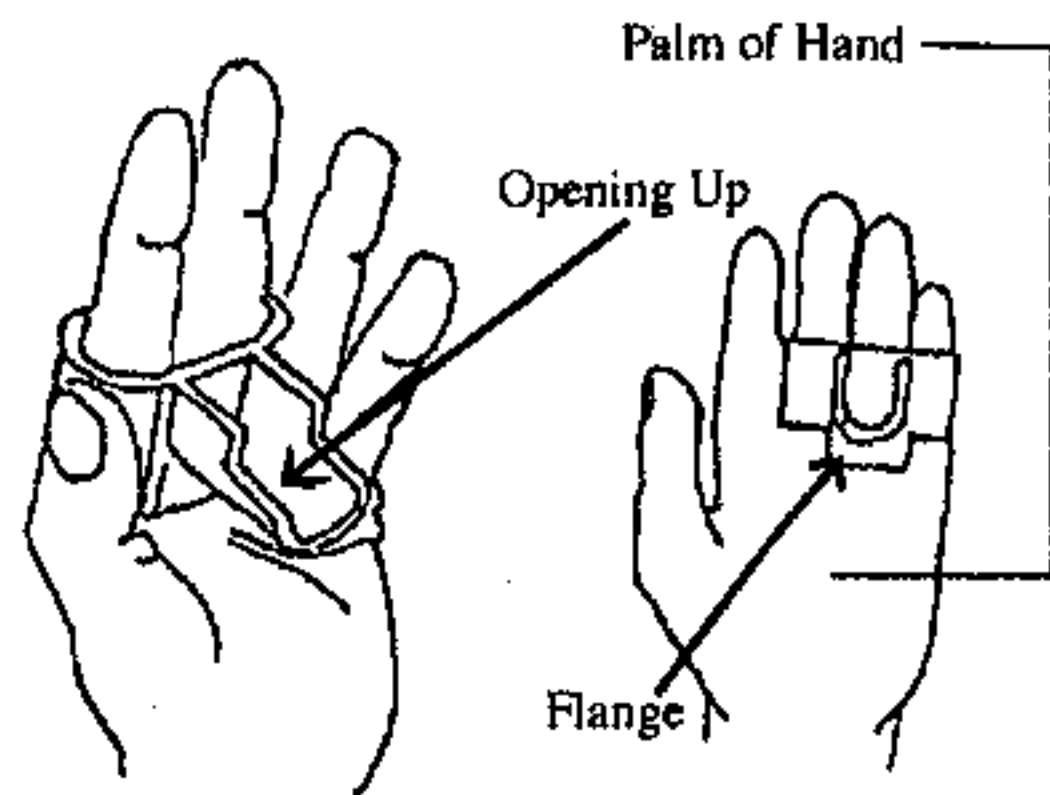
Instruction Booklet

It makes tying balloons so easy it's fun!



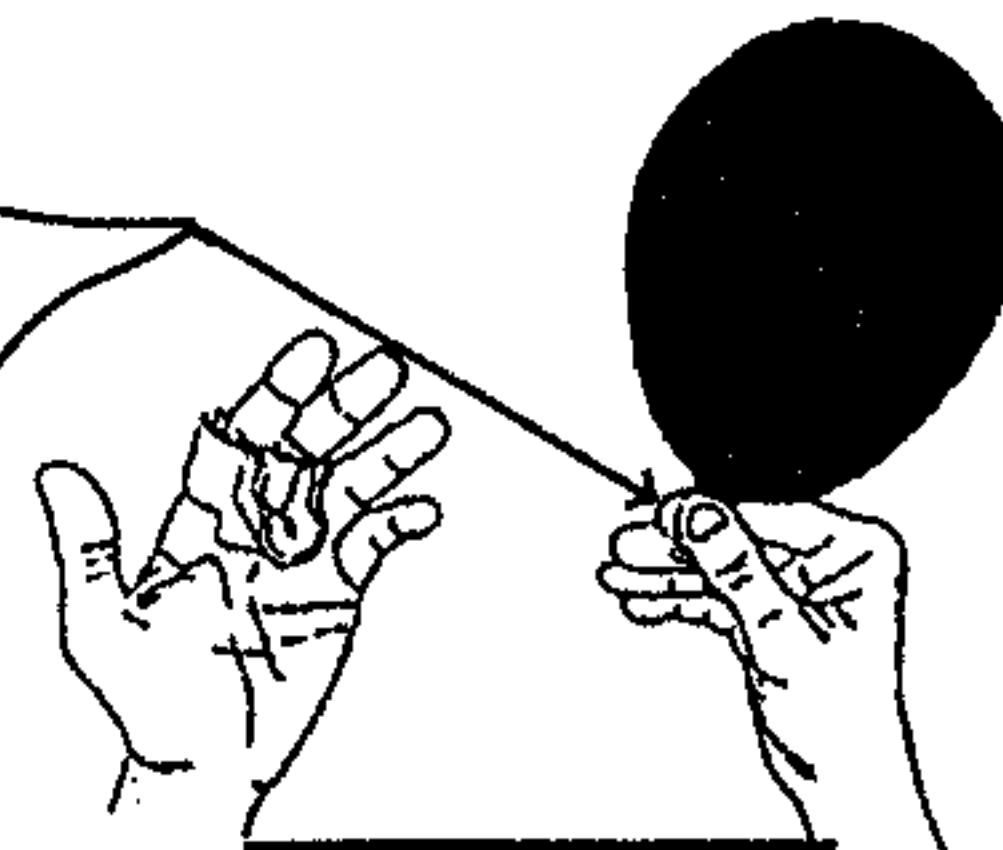
Before starting you must unfold this entire booklet and look at all 5 steps closely or using the Tie-A-Balloon will be difficult.

Step 1

Place the tying device on the pointer and second fingers (possibly a third finger or the last three fingers) with the opening on top, put the flange toward the palm of the hand. Inflate the balloon.

STOP!

Look closely at the way the balloon is in the hand. The balloon should be upright!

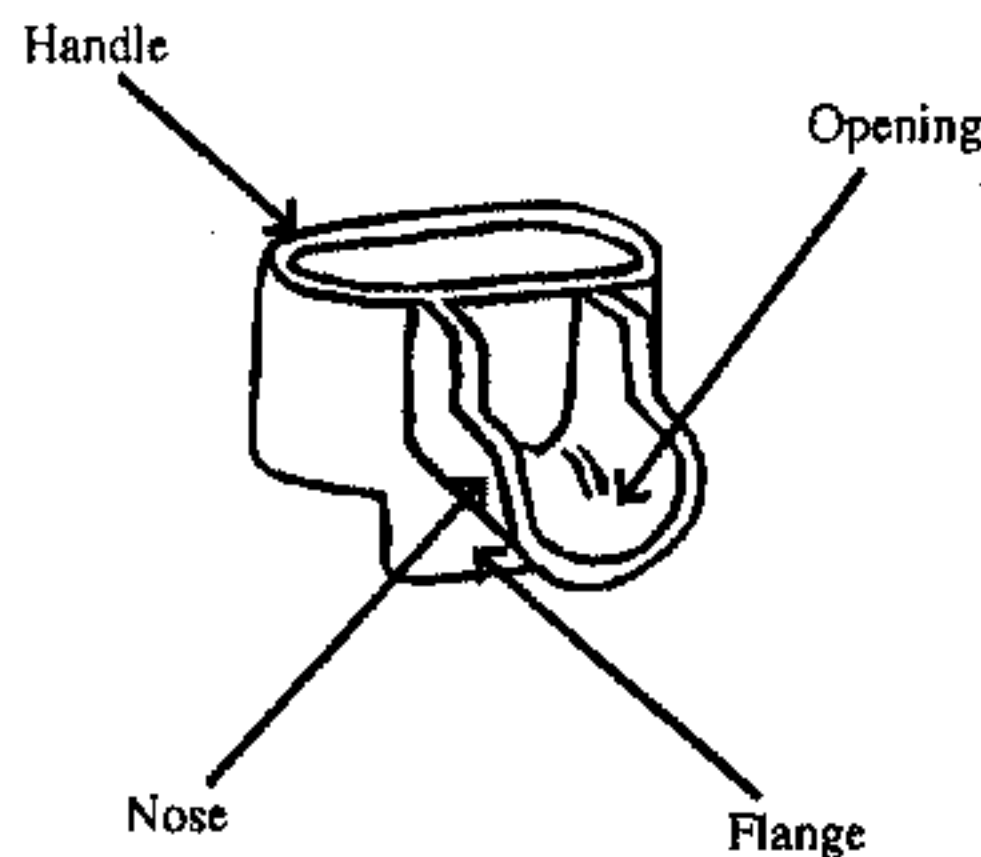


Step 2

In this picture you need to pay close attention to the way the person is holding the balloon. If you do not hold the balloon in the upright position you will not be able to use the tie-a-balloon correctly. It is very important to hold the balloon in the upright position.

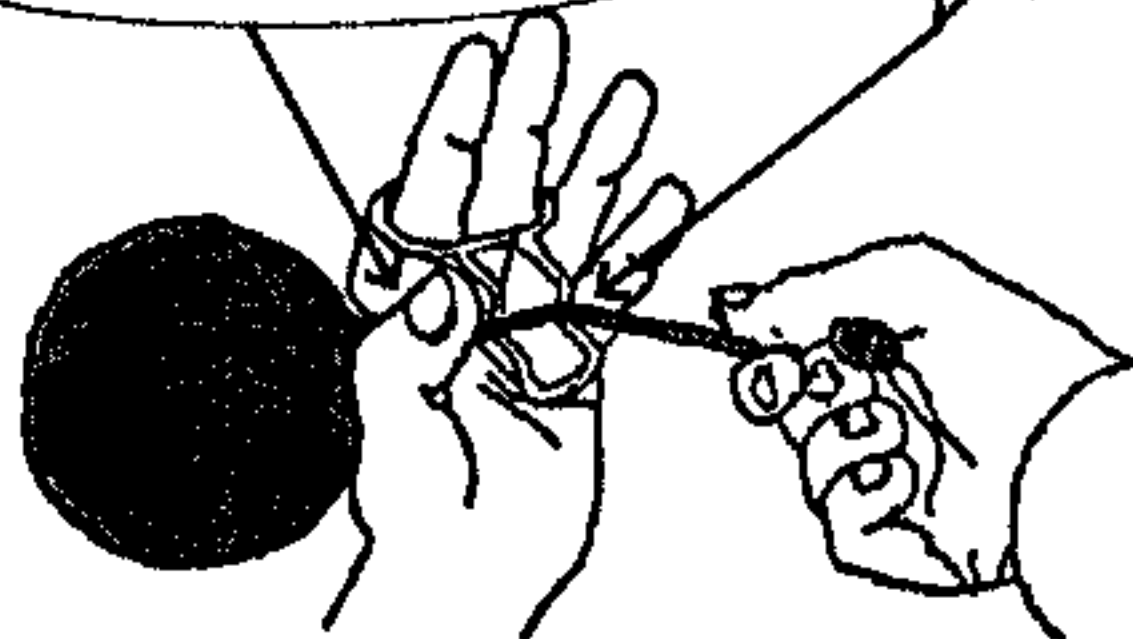
Tie-A-Balloon™

Description



STOP! Look closely. The neck of the balloon goes over the top of the nose.

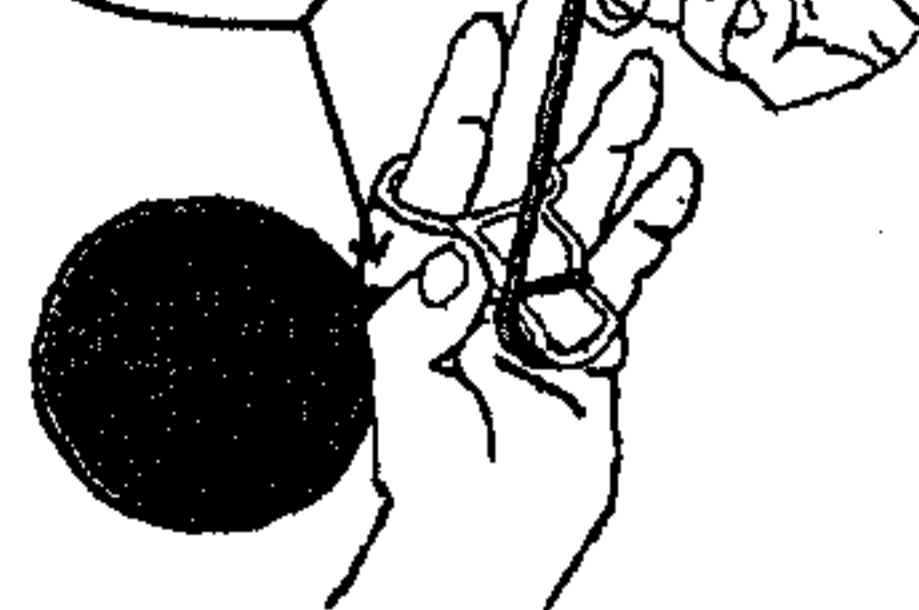
Balloon goes behind the thumb.



Step 3

Holding the opening of the balloon, put the inflated part in between the thumb and the device. Now, hold and stretch. Keep stretching the neck of the balloon and go over the top of the opening.

Balloon goes behind the thumb.

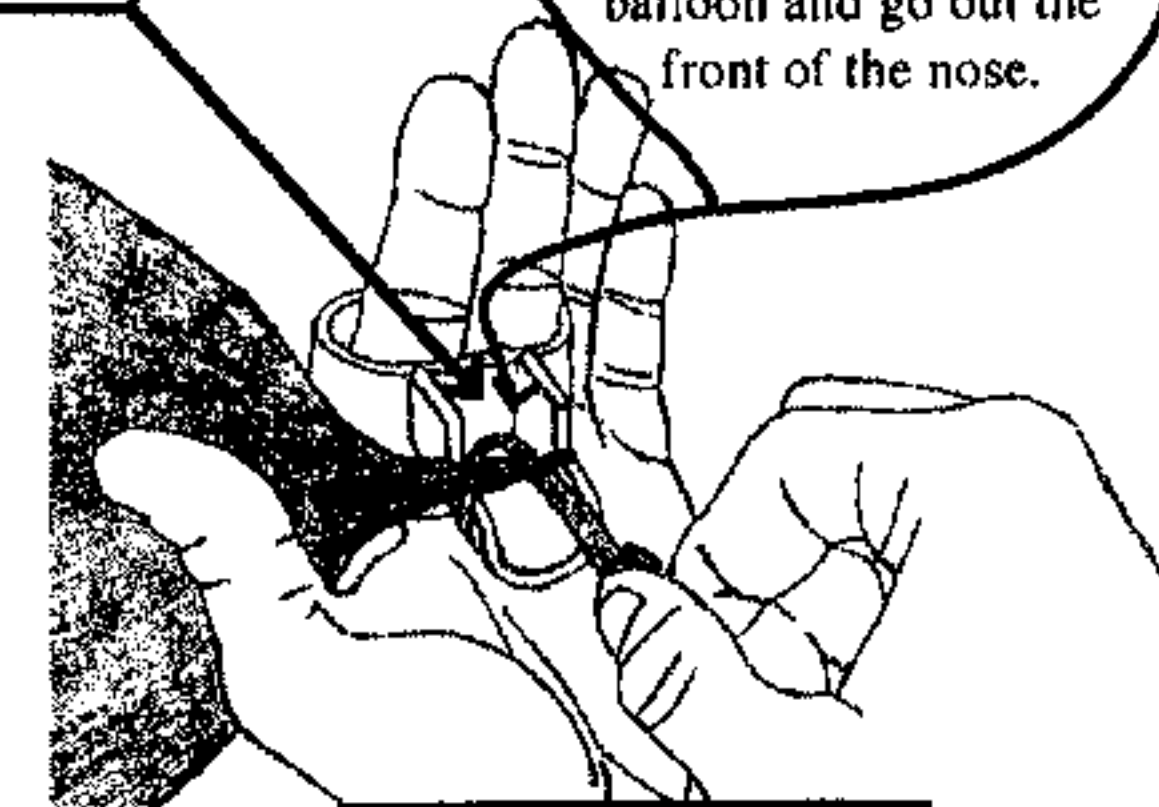


Step 4

Stretching the balloon, wind it under and around the nose.

Don't leave finger in the opening when making the knot.

Put the opening of the balloon down in the back side of the nose and go under the stretched balloon and go out the front of the nose.



Step 5

Put the balloon's opening back behind the stretched balloon and down through the tie nose opening. Then grab the balloon's opening with the index finger and thumb and pull the balloon. Do not be afraid of breaking the balloon; the balloon is tough. Just grab the opening of the balloon and give it a good hard pull. Pull fast; the faster you pull the better.
